## PARTITION WALL MADE OF CONCRETE BLOCKS (steel carpentry)

The partition wall is made of concrete blocks of  $39 \times 19 \times 9$  cm, laid with cement mortar. When two partition walls are jointed, alternately "pass" one piece of each partition wall to get a good joint.

The steel frame is filled in with fiberglass, which can works like thermal or acoustic insulation. The door frame is laid to the partition wall through welded anchors.

Some finishing concrete blocks have been placed to finish the sides.
