MASONRY STAIRS

The flights and the landing are made of a double row of large bricks; they are laid with cement mortar and support them with one of their edges on the brickwork wall. This brickwork wall is plastered in both faces; on the other edge, the large bricks are supported to a brickwork partition. This partition is made of solid brick and it has connection pieces (steel bars) into it. All of the system is plastered in both faces.

On the built in of the steps have been used double hollow bricks, solid bricks and single hollow bricks; over them have been laid three ways of step pieces.
