MASONRY

FAÇADE MADE OF BRICKWORK (steel carpentry)

The wall is made of perforated brick laid with cement mortar and English bond.

An "L" profile 100.10 has been anchored to the brickwork like support and fixing the metal joist deck.

To support the window lintel, two "L" profiles have been placed like supports; and for sharing out the weights of them, these profiles are supported into the brickwork through metallic plates anchored to it.

All of the metallic elements have been protected with a primer of red lead layer.

On the exterior side of the wall have been placed a shutters made of metal. These shutters are laid to the brickwork and they have two folding window panes.

The brickwork has been cladded outside with rough plastering and painted.
