AWNING WINDOW FOR ROOFS

This awning window for roofs is made of laminated timber and it is covered with aluminum profiles. It has double insulation security glass and friction hinges to let the window opened in three different positions: 5°, 15° and 30°.

The window opens through a handle on the lower of the leaf. The handle bar is on the top can be used to open the ventilation piece or to spin the leaf 107°, making easy the exterior cleaning.

The ventilation piece lets the air entrance without open the window; it has a filter to avoid the dust and insect entrance.

Under the window there is a transom with hinge on the lower side. This transom opens inwards the room through a lock on the top, with two positions: cleaning and ventilation.

The good sealing is achieved through a drain to collect rainwater in the top of it.
