SLOPED ROOFS

SLOPED ROOF WITH CURVED TILE

The sloping has been made of ceramic bricks over the slab; finished off with a plaster coat.

Over them are placed ceramic bricks deck with a paper sheet to avoid the expansion joint between the decks and the ceramic bricks.

Over the ceramic bricks deck is spread a cement mortar coat, and over it are placed the curved tiles. These curved tiles are received with cement mortar every five rows.

You can see these details:

- The link between a field of roof and the chimney, finished off with a lead sheet which overlaps under the tile and continues to the hollow brick partition which coats the chimney. This lead sheet will have a little sloping to flow the rainwater.
- The building of the roofing with mortar, finishing off with lead sheet overlapped under the roof tiles to get a good sealing.
- The finishing of the roof with double coat of curved tile.
